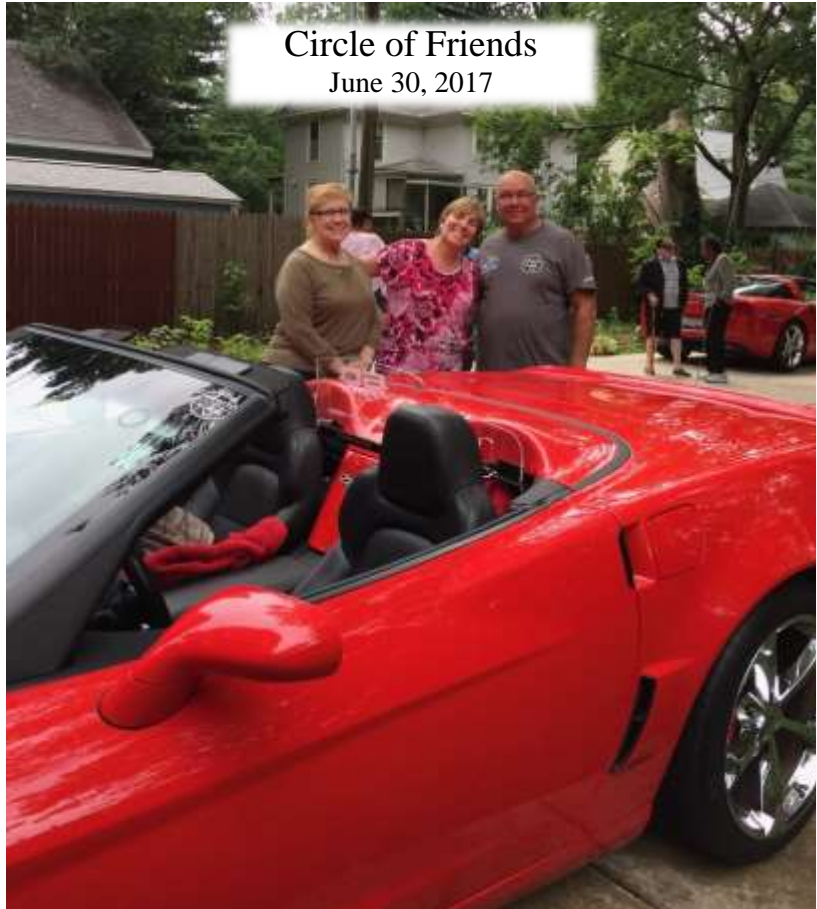

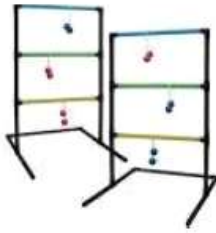

Map and Directions to Comlara Park

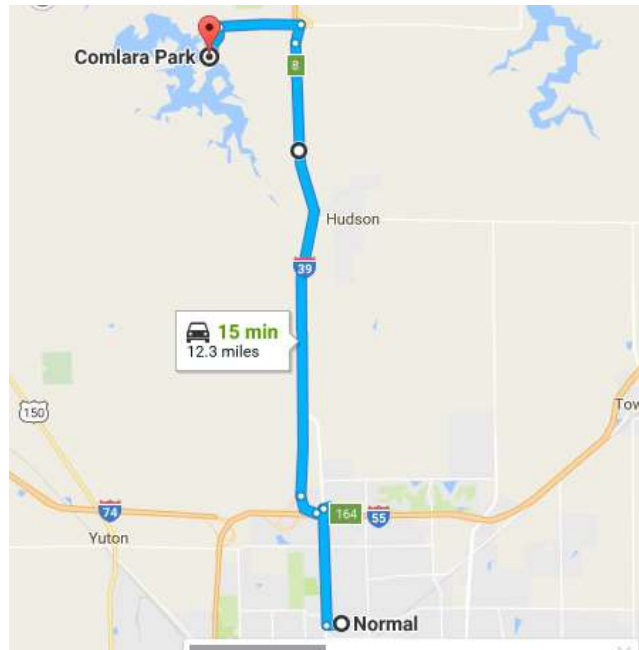
Take I-39 to Exit 8 for IL-251 toward Kappa/Lake Bloomington Rd.
