In 1959, pizza was a new concept to many folks. The popularity of Joe's pizza increased, and in 1962 a larger facility was needed. Demand for his pizza continued to increase and in 1974, Joe bought an old warehouse and converted it to a one of a kind pizzeria which is located at 18162 Harwood Ave. in Homewood, Illinois and remains as Aurelio's flagship restaurant. Also in 1974, Aurelio's was the first Chicago pizzeria to franchise it's restaurant concept. Aurelio's has now grown to 33 restaurants in Illinois, Indiana, Florida, Georgia, Minnesota, Florida and Nevada. Their menu of course offers a wide range of pizza's from thin to thick crust with a large selection of toppings.
