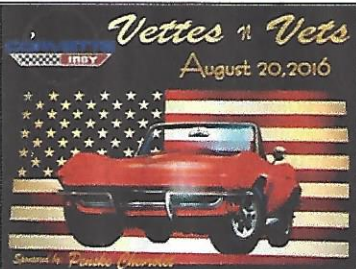

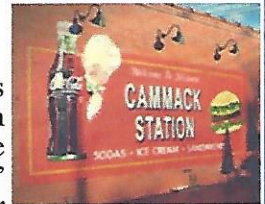
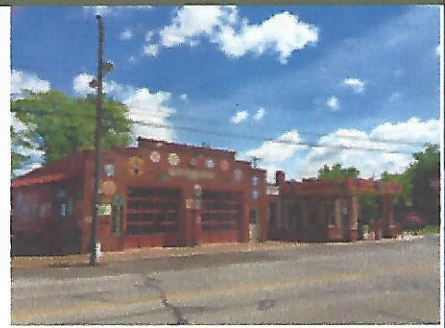
## "A Fork on the Road"

Owner Dick Howe purchased the building in 2007 and turned it into an eating establishment, that as he puts it, is "a welcome break from today's chain restaurants". This historic building was built in 1931 and served as many different grocery and fueling stations through it's history. Much of the buildings history is displayed as pictures and antiques, on the walls, and accompanied by "oldies" music in the background. Menu items include Burger and Dawg sandwich baskets as well as other speciality sandwich baskets. They even have fried Bologna sandwiches on the menu. Other side choices are available and include fried pickles and fried mac and cheese. Salads and soups are available, as well as various soft drinks. The dessert menu choices almost out number the regular menu items. Ice Cream, Milk Shakes, Sundaes, Floats, cobbler, shortcake, the list goes on and on.
